

.01 Quality Assurance: Add all the of the following clauses:

- .1 *All preparation, materials, and workmanship shall be in strict accordance with NFCA requirements and material manufacturers written recommendations and detail requirements for conditions of work that apply and guarantee / warranty periods noted herein.*
- .2 *Any preparation, materials, and workmanship that do not meet NFCA requirements shall be repaired or replaced in accordance with Quality Assurance requirements at no additional cost to the Owner.*

**Where the Quality Assurance Program (QAP) is required add all of the following clauses. (Refer to PART A04 General Requirements in the Floor Covering Reference Manual for more QAP information).**

- .3 *All work within this specification shall be included under the Quality Assurance Program (QAP) and shall be reviewed in strict accordance with NFCA QAP requirements by a qualified (i.e. QAP accredited Inspection Agency assigned by the Provincial Floor Covering Trade Association having jurisdiction. The cost (based on 4% of the total cost of flooring work, including a 100% two year Maintenance Bond) shall be included in the cost for this work. A minimum cost of \$3500 shall apply.*
- .4 *All Flooring Contractors bidding this work shall contact the QAP provider for any clarifications prior to submitting a bid for this work.*
- .5 *On award of the flooring contract, request a QA Review Form and submit prior to ordering flooring materials.*

**Note that the flooring contract must be awarded in a timely manner in order to initiate the QA program and to ensure an early review of the flooring specifications by the QA inspector.**
